Our environmental policy is to continuously improve the environmental protection system in accordance with the ČSN EN ISO 14001 standard. We apply this policy in relation to all stakeholders.

The environmental management system relates to the company's activities that have an impact on the environmental profile and is limited to the company KOH-I-NOOR RONAS, sro

- with the premises of the Tool Factory at 1. máje 2631, 756 61 Rožnov pod Radhoštěm and the premises of the Plastic Molding Factory at Dopravní 2644, 756 61 Rožnov pod Radhoštěm,
- in the area: **development and production of plastic injection molds, tools for cutting and forming sheets, production and supply of plastic parts.**

### The management of KOH-I-NOOR RONAS sro undertakes to:

1.	To continuously improve the environmental management system to increase environmental performance.
2.	To protect the environment and natural resources and to prevent environmental pollution.
3.	To comply with relevant legal requirements and other requirements that relate to our environmental aspects and impacts.
4.	To provide resources to ensure the functioning of the EMS.
5.	To ensure the continuous reduction of negative impacts in all its activities and services using the best available economically viable technologies.
6.	To prevent possible emergencies through your actions and behavior.
7.	To reduce the energy intensity of production and manage natural resources in a sustainable manner.
8.	To educate and motivate company employees to protect and create a healthy environment.
9.	To minimize the amount of waste generated within its operations, landfilling waste only in cases where no other suitable and more environmentally friendly disposal method is available.
10.	CO <sub>2</sub> and other greenhouse gas emissions through energy savings and optimization of your processes.
11.	To take into account the risks and opportunities associated with climate change when planning and managing activities and strengthening the resilience of operations to its impacts.
12.	To apply product life cycle principles when making decisions about materials, technologies, mold design, and the production of plastic parts with the aim of minimizing the overall environmental footprint.
13.	To support the protection of biodiversity by preventing plastic granulate leaks, responsible management of chemicals and care for company land.

The establishment of objectives, targets and programmes of the environmental management system and their regular evaluation is an elaboration of this policy. We support and require the active participation of employees in the implementation of this policy.
